Access to **hand sanitizing** stations. **Distancing markers** on the floor.



All volunteers will wear a **mask**, and an usher will **seat you** in the sanctuary.



We will **NOT** offer coffee, tea, refreshments or access to the water cooler.  
*\*You are welcome to bring your own coffee or tea into the sanctuary.*



All high-volume areas + chairs will be **sanitized** before and after each service.



We will provide an **offering box** at our exit instead of passing offering bags.

### WHAT WE ASK OF YOU...



Prior to Sunday, **RESERVE YOUR SEAT** by signing-up, as space is limited.

Please arrive **15 mins.** before the service to 'check-in' upon arrival.



Provincial Guidelines require **masks** for Indoor Public Spaces. (i.e. Sunday Service) Please wear your mask when moving around in the church.  
*\*Those with a valid medical reason or children under 2 are exempt.*



Maintain **6ft distancing** between yourself and others, and follow signage.  
*\*No handshakes, hugs, or mingling in the lobby. Please exit the church promptly.*



Please **remain seated** during the entire service. You are welcome to **sing**.



**Washrooms** are available; 1 person at a time or immediate family members.



Please use **hand sanitizer** often and practice good personal hygiene.

## KENTVILLE

### Programming for Kids Age 4-10 @ 9:30AM & 11AM

Parents/Guardians and Kids can expect a 1-hour, interactive and socially distanced experience, and we will do all that we can to provide a safe environment for your children and our HopeKids Leaders.

#### **Sign-in / Sign-Out** (Lower Level)

- When signing your child(ren) in and out of our program, we ask that you follow the distancing/direction markers on the floor to help us with social distancing.
- Prior to service, Parents/Guardians will sign-in and drop off their children at our HopeKids area.
- The “self check-in” computer will not be available. All HopeKids will be signed in by the HopeKids sign-in team member.
- After the service, we ask that parents/guardians stop at the sign-in desk to have their child(ren) signed out before collecting their child(ren). This will make the flow of traffic much smoother.

#### **Programming / Social Distancing**

- We will have enough spaces set up for children to have their own space/share a space with their sibling(s) while social distancing from others.
- In each space, children will have their own bin of craft supplies, etc. to use during the program and free time.
- Our program will consist of worship, a Bible story, and a craft / game.
- We will not be providing snacks, but we may give out (pre-packaged) candy as prizes for children to bring home.

#### **Masks / Personal Hygiene**

We will be following similar mask guidelines as the public school system.

- We ask that children & adults wear masks when entering/exiting HopeKids area.
- When socially distanced and instructed to by a HopeKids leader, children may remove their mask if they are comfortable doing so.
- HopeKids Leaders will wear masks when they are not able to social distance.
- We will have plenty of tissues, soap, water, and hand sanitizer available to assist our HopeKids in practicing good personal hygiene.

#### **Family Room** (Upper Level)

Our Family Room is available for infants and toddlers. Children must be supervised by their caregivers as this room is not staffed by a HopeKids Leader.

- Room is equipped with toys, washroom/changing station & TV feed of the service.

## KINGSTON

(418 Markland Road, Kingston, NS)

### Programming for Kids Age 4-10 @ 10:30AM

Parents/Guardians and Kids can expect a 1-hour, interactive and socially distanced experience, and we will do all that we can to provide a safe environment for your children and our HopeKids Leaders.

### Sign-in / Sign-Out

- Prior to service, Parents/Guardians will sign-in their children at our HopeKids area.
- When signing your child(ren) in and out of our program, we ask that you follow the distancing/direction markers on the floor to help us with social distancing.

### Programming / Social Distancing

- Children will remain in the sanctuary with their families for the beginning of the service and will be dismissed to the HopeKids area after the music.
- When children arrive at the HopeKids area, the HopeKids leader(s) will show children where to sit.
  - Children will sit in “family bubbles” (immediate, extended, or bubble) and there will be 6ft distancing between each bubble in the HopeKids area.
  - Each bubble will have its own bin of craft supplies etc. to use during the program and during free time.
- Our program will consist of a Bible story and a craft / game.
- We will not be providing snacks, but we may give out (pre-packaged) candy as prizes for children to bring home.

### Masks / Personal Hygiene

We will be following similar mask guidelines as the public school system.

- We recommend that children wear masks when walking from the sanctuary to the HopeKids area.
- Children will not have to wear a mask while sitting in their bubbles, but we ask that they wait for the leader to instruct them to take their mask off.
- HopeKids Leaders will wear masks when they are not able to social distance.

### HopeNest (Far corner of the Lobby)

Our HopeNest area is available for infants and toddlers. Children must be supervised by their caregivers as this space is not staffed by a HopeKids Leader.

- This space is equipped with toys, and hygiene items.
