Teachers/Leaders	Check-In	Helpers/Floaters
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - We are looking for creative, caring, and committed Teachers/Leaders who are passionate about sharing the truths of Jesus with kids! If you have the gift(s) of teaching, serving, knowledge, wisdom, and/or leadership, this may be a great opportunity for you. - Support the Children's Pastor by teaching the lesson (curriculum provided), leading a craft/game for one of the following groups: nursery, elementary or Gr.1-5. - Kentville: 1h program (18 months - grade 5) on Sundays that seeks to provide an authentic worship and learning experience for kids. - Kingston & Windsor: A 30min program for ages 4-10. Kids are dismissed halfway thru service. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - We are looking for check-in leaders who are tech-savvy, enjoy making a great first impression, and prioritize safety. If you have the gift(s) of administration, serving, helps, &/or hospitality, this may be a great opportunity for you! - Every child that attends our HopeKids Program is 'checked into' our system to ensure the safety of parents, children, & volunteers. Check-in team member greets parents/kids, and oversees the check-in process on the Computer before the Sunday service and assists with the check-out after the service. - Kentville/Kingston/Windsor: Parents or Guardians check-in their kid(s) <i>10 mins prior</i> to service & check-out after service. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - We are looking for Helper/Floater (adults or youth) who enjoy working behind the scenes, &/or assist the Teacher/Leader.
